#### Respirators

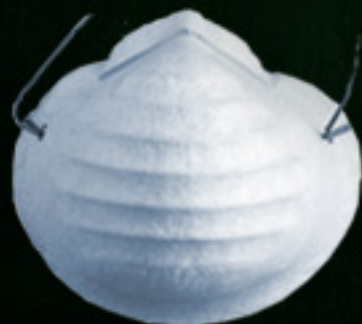

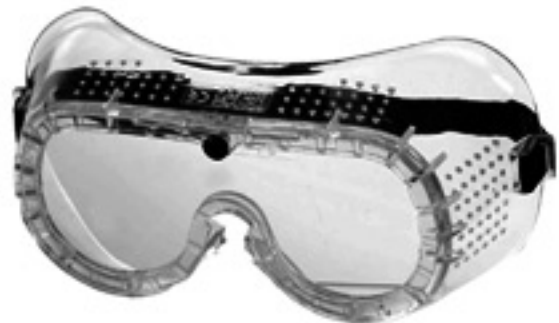
